Legal aspects of organizing mass events

Abstract

The article touched legal aspects of managing sports infrastructure in connection with the organization of mass events on the example of the Ski Jumping World Cup in Wisła. It is focused mainly on the safety requirements for mass events, including tasks assigned to the security service and information services, in accordance with the actually law. It presented the subject matter of the permits to organize a mass event and the process of obtaining them. It indicated limits of legal responsibility of the organizer of mass events too. Obtaining a permit is time-consuming and bureaucratic, but the procedures and requirements for event organizers are clearly specified and specific, so that events can be in progress to the safety of the participants. Failure to comply with the provisions contained in the documentation may result in criminal liability of the organizer. The purpose of the work was to get answers to questions, if it is possible to simplify the process of obtaining permits for organizing mass events and if it will not negatively affect their safety. To know the opinion of the organizers on this subject the test was carried out, whose results were included in the thesis.
